Grading system at INSA

INSA ROUEN NORMANDIE uses the 20 point scale used in the **French grading system**. A grade of 20 represents **the highest grade**, while 0 is the lowest. In reality it is rare to see grades below 8 or above 16. Marks of 20, 19 and 18 are very rarely given. Students must obtain an overall average of 10 or above in each thematically-grouped block (called "UE") of courses, (called "ECs"), in order to pass from one year of study to the next. This rule does not apply to exchange students who can choose courses from different UEs, each course being graded separately.
